Text: John 1:29-42 (Memory verse: Acts 1:8)

Discussion Questions

- If you got saved the first time you heard the Gospel you are the rare exception. Who were the people God used to plant and water the seed (God's Word) in your life before you accepted Jesus
- How many times did you hear the Gospel before you got saved? If a lot, why should that only serve to encourage, not discourage, us to share the Gospel with others?

Application Questions

1. In the Old Testament, God never told the Jews to "go out" and get people. Instead, they were told to erect a beautiful structure, the temple, which would be a means of drawing people to Judaism. Unlike Israel, the church has been called to GO! (See Matthew 28:18-19) In what ways has the church ignored this clear command from Jesus?
2. During the sermon Pastor said the two reasons why every Christian should share Jesus with others is because they know Him and He is worth sharing (Luke 8:38-39). How can keeping it that simple make it seem like less of a task and more of a privilege?
3. We have already seen that we are called to share. We are also called to let our light shine (Matthew 5:14-16). Why are both vitally important?
4. Though "going" may never be easy for us, what promises can we cling to as we do?

 - Acts 1:8, 4:31
 - John 14:26-27
 - 1 Corinthians 3:5-6

5. Who do you know that needs to hear about Jesus from you?

6. How might you go about witnessing to them over the next few days/weeks?
